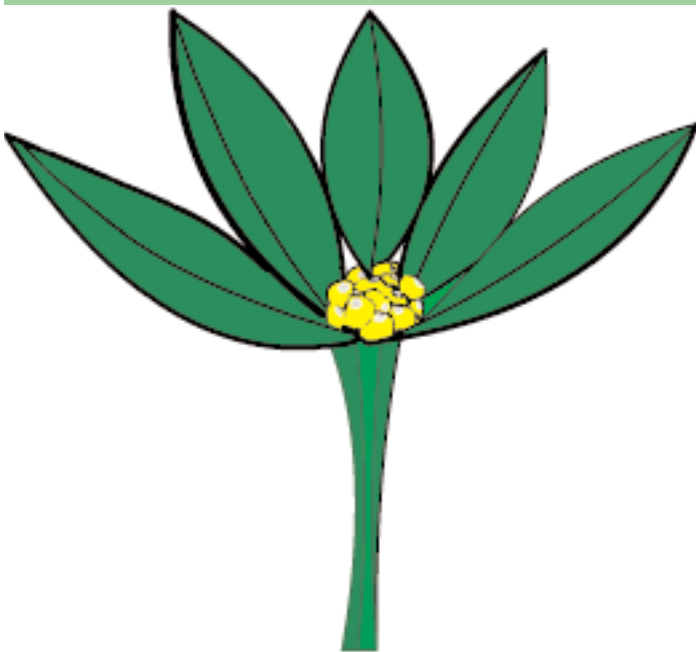


# B I O D I E S E L

## What is Biodiesel??

**B**iodiesel is an environmentally friendly fuel that can be used in vehicles with diesel engines!! Unlike regular oil, biodiesel is simple to use, biodegradable, non-toxic, and essentially free of sulfur.

**C**ertain plants --pictured below -- can produce soybeans. The byproduct of soybean, when broken down and refined by manufacturers, can be used as an environmentally friendly oil for diesel engines.



**B**iodiesel that is produced for use in vehicles is a legal motor fuel for retail sale and distribution.

**R**aw vegetable oil cannot meet biodiesel fuel specifications. It is not registered with the EPA, and it is not a legal motor fuel.

## Why Should I Use Biodiesel?

**B**iodiesel is better for the environment because it is made

from renewable resources and has lower emissions compared to petroleum diesel. It is less toxic than table salt and biodegrades as fast as sugar. Since it is made in the USA from renewable resources such as soybeans, its use decreases our dependence on foreign oil.

## How can I Purchase Biodiesel?

**B**iodiesel can be purchased through suppliers, distributors and retail outlets in almost every state. Nationwide, biodiesel is usually priced less than non-biodiesel fuel due to the lack of import tariffs from foreign sources and cheaper manufacturing costs.
